North Syracuse Fire Department Junior Rules and Regulations

1. Members shall be no younger than fourteen (14) years old and no older than eighteen (18) years old.
2. Each member shall have the written consent of a parent or guardian.
3. Membership must not exceed fifteen (15) members at any given time.
4. Members shall be under the authority of their Advisors and the Chief Officers of the North Syracuse Fire Department.
5. The following are prohibited in the Fire Station, at drills, or any Fire Department functions.
 - a. Fighting
 - b. Consumption of alcohol
 - c. Substance abuse
 - d. Smoking
 - e. Running in the station, at drills or scenes
 - f. Foul language
 - g. Horse play
6. Juniors are not permitted at the station or on scenes during school hours. They are permitted at the station from 9:00am to 9:00pm. The only exceptions to these rules are for special occasions approved by a Fire Department Chief Officer.

7. No Junior Firefighter will ride any first or second due apparatus to any fire or emergency alarm. You will be permitted to ride on the last piece or with a Chief to the scene of an emergency. Responding to the scene in a private vehicle is prohibited.
8. Full turnout gear will be worn by all Junior Firefighters on the scene of any alarms. Junior Firefighters are not allowed on the scene of a structure fire without the permission of the incident commander.
9. No Junior Firefighters are allowed in the weight room without the supervision of one of their advisors.
10. No Junior Firefighters are allowed to use the fire station as a sleeping quarters or a hangout.
11. No Junior Firefighters are allowed in the fire station unless there is a North Syracuse Firefighter present.
12. Remember you are representing the North Syracuse Junior Fire Department and the North Syracuse Fire Department. Each Junior Firefighter will act as a professional Firefighter at all times.

There will be certain scholastic requirements each Junior Firefighter will be required to maintain. At each marking period, the Junior Firefighter will be required to produce their report card. The Junior Firefighter should not be failing any classes. If the Junior Firefighter is failing two (2) or more subjects, they will be placed on suspension until they show proof that they are improving in the failing classes. The Junior Firefighter must show weekly proof that they are improving until the subjects they failed are changed to a passing grade on their next five (5) week report or report card. As with all rules the Chief's office has the final say in all matters.

Note to Parents: The objective of the Junior Fire Department is to teach members to become a Firefighter when they come of age. Firefighting is a very dangerous occupation; there are many hazards that are uncontrollable. As a Junior Firefighter, your child may be placed in situations where they may become accidentally injured. You must realize that no one will be hurt intentionally or placed in situations where we know they will be hurt. I understand that any false answer, statement, implication, the omission of any pertinent or required information made by me on this application or other required documents shall be considered sufficient cause for denial of membership or removal from the active roster of this department. I also understand that all equipment issued to me shall remain property of the North Syracuse Fire Department and must be surrendered upon termination of membership. There is a limited number of Juniors allowed and I could be placed on a waiting list for membership.
